College Goal Wisconsin Offers Free Help with College Financial Aid

Wisconsin students can get free help completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at College Goal Wisconsin events held throughout the state. Financial aid professionals and other educators volunteer at the event to help students and their families complete the FAFSA.

Anyone who is planning to pursue a postsecondary education in the 2018-19 academic year should complete the FAFSA. That includes high school seniors, continuing college students, transfer students, and adult students considering pursuing higher education. The FAFSA is the form that must be submitted in order to be considered for federal and state financial aid including grants and loans.

Students pursuing a postsecondary education in 2018-19 can access the FAFSA beginning October 1, 2017. Forty-three College Goal Wisconsin events will take place between October 4 and November 8. In addition to getting professional help completing the FAFSA, attendees will have the opportunity to enter a scholarship drawing.
