BE SURE TO:

1. Apply to college.
2. Apply for financial aid at the colleges you plan to apply. You do not have to be accepted to college to apply for financial aid.
3. Continually check your college student email account (you'll get information on how to do this after you are accepted).
4. Check the FAFSA priority date at the college you plan to attend.
5. Complete and submit the 2018-19 FAFSA online (www.fafsa.gov).
6. Review the FAFSA Confirmation Report.
7. Receive the Student Aid Report electronically 2-4 days after you submit the FAFSA.
8. Provide the necessary documentation to the college financial aid office as requested.
9. Review the financial aid award notification and accept the funds offered.
