1. Apply to college.
2. Apply for a FSA ID <https://fsaid.ed.gov>
3. You do not have to be accepted to a college to apply for financial aid.
4. Check the FAFSA priority date at the college you plan to attend.
5. Complete and submit the 2019-20 FAFSA online (<https://fafsa.ed.gov/>).
6. Review the FAFSA Confirmation Report.
7. Receive the Student Aid Report electronically 2-4 days after you submit the FAFSA.
8. Once you are accepted to your college, be sure to check your student account for various messages.
9. Check to see if your college requires an additional institutional financial aid application.
10. Provide the necessary documentation to the college financial aid office as requested.
11. Review the financial aid award notification and accept the funds offered.

- ✓ 2017 Federal Tax Return
- ✓ W-2 Wage Statements
- ✓ 2017 Untaxed Income such as child support paid or received
- ✓ Asset information
- ✓ Driver's License
- ✓ Social Security Number (need student and parent(s))
- ✓ Birth dates of parent(s)
- ✓ Date mom and dad were married, separated, or divorced
